The goal of the poster exhibition is to highlight recent discoveries and research in the field of civil engineering. The exhibition intends to give undergraduate students a stage on which to showcase their studies and expertise on a range of civil engineering topics, such as environmental engineering, water resources engineering, transportation engineering, structural engineering, and geotechnical engineering. In civil engineering, the application of environmentally friendly and sustainable solutions is critical due to population growth and infrastructure development. In addition, the competition will offer a chance to investigate the most recent developments and breakthroughs in civil engineering and obtain perspectives on the field's future. Through this exhibition, students will be inspired to make a difference in the area of civil engineering and be encouraged to think critically and apply their knowledge to real-world challenges.

Rules & Regulations:

Team Formation:

- Only undergraduate students are eligible to participate in this segment.
- A minimum of 1 and a maximum of 2 members should make up each team.
- Each team is required to have a specific team name.
- There is no scope for spot registration and payment.

Abstract Submission:

- The topic for the poster must fall under one of the following divisions of civil engineering: geotechnical engineering, structural engineering, transportation engineering, water resources engineering or environmental engineering.
- Participants have to register their team by google form and each team will submit an abstract (not more than 300 words) in a .docx format file before the deadline. The abstract should contain the main theme of the poster, which has to be submitted in Times New Roman and font size will be 12. After the primary screening of the abstracts, 5 topics from each division will be selected for the final presentation.
- The selected teams will be notified by email to pay the registration fee and complete the registration.
- No registration fee is required for abstract submission.

Poster Features:

- The Poster Size Must be: 3ft Vertical x 2ft Horizontal.
- Poster material: PVC banner.
- Participants can use their project or thesis topic as the subject of the poster.
- At least one member from each team must be constantly present with their poster throughout the whole presentation and judgment.

Judging Criteria:

It will be up to the judges to decide whether any regulations have been broken. They will make a definitive decision that is not subject to appeal. The following will be the judging criteria:

- Clarity and understanding of the topic (30%)
- Creativity of the presentation (30%)
- Interview and Q&A Session (20%)
- Engagement of the Whole Team (20%)

Note: The rules and regulations outlined above are subject to change at the discretion of the organizing committee. Participants are advised to check for updates and announcements regarding the competition regularly.
